Newport Television, LLC., its subsidiaries and affiliated companies (together, the "Company"), will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules, and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

1. Description of Contest/Participation.

A. Dates of Contest: The Contest will begin on or about February 13, 2012. The Grand Prize winner will be announced on March 14, 2012.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING. Void where prohibited. Odds of winning depend upon the number of entries received.

B. To Enter:

Register by logging onto the Station's website at www.cbs47.tv and follow the Contest links to download and fully complete **both**: (1) the registration form with (2) couple profile race form. Valid entries must contain all information requested on each couple contestant. Contest is for couples who are getting married and single entries will not be accepted. Incomplete and/or multiple entries will be disqualified. One entry per couple. Deadline for registration is 11:59 p.m. PT on February 27, 2012. All entries become the property of CBS47 and will not be returned.

C. Winner Selection:

On or about February 28, 2012 through March 2, 2012, based on qualifying entries submitted, the Station Panel will select, in its sole discretion, three (3) finalists based on the registration materials. All decisions of the Station and judges are final.

The three (3) couples selected as finalists must be available and agree to be married at noon at Wonder Valley Ranch on Friday, May 18, 2012. Finalist couples must be available to be photographed and interviewed at their home or place of residence anytime before 10:00 p.m. on March 2, 2012 or March 3, 2012. Finalist couples must be available to appear for a live interview on "CBS47 This Morning" from 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. on March 5, 2012, March 6, 2012 or March 7, 2012. Finalist couples agree to allow their photographs and biographies on KGPE TV and posted on the Station's website at cbs47.tv for online viewer voting. Projected dates and timelines are subject to change.

On or about March 5, 2012, viewers will be invited to vote for one of the three finalist couples they believe should win the Grand Prize Wedding. Voting will be open between 6:00 a.m. (P.S.T.) on March 5, 2012 and continue through 5:00 p.m. (P.S.T.) March 13, 2012. Voting is limited to one vote per IP address. Multiple votes will be disqualified. Multiple voting may result in the disqualification of a finalist or finalists, in the Company's sole discretion. Any attempt to advance yourself by promotion through the public voting process must be approved in advance by CBS47. The couple which receives the most votes will be declared the Grand Prize winner. In the event of a tie, a run-off vote will be held and the couple with the greatest number of on-line run-off votes will win the Grand Prize. Winning couple agrees to be available to appear on CBS47 This Morning on March 14th for live broadcast announcement or anytime as needed between March 14, 2012 and through May 16, 2012.

2. Prize(s). The prize(s) that may be awarded to the eligible winner(s) are: One Grand Prize Winning Couple will receive a wedding prize package selected by on-line viewer voting. The wedding will take place at 12:00 p.m. on May 18, 2012 at Wonder Valley Ranch in Sanger, California and will accommodate 100 guests (including the bridal party). Each part of the wedding provided by the Station is at the sole discretion of the Station.

Actual wedding and reception date is May 18, 2012. If winning couple is unavailable on this date, the Station reserves the right to choose another winner. Winning couple is ultimately responsible for their own wedding plans and any local and/or state marriage licensing requirements.

3. Eligibility and Limitations. Participants and winner(s) must be residents of Central San Joaquin Valley DMA (which includes the counties of Fresno, Madera, Modesto, Merced, Tulare and Mariposa) and both must be 18-years or older at the time of entry. Entrants must be engaged at the time of entry and eligible for marriage in the State of California in accordance with all applicable laws. Couples must not have a current contract with Wonder Valley Ranch Resort for their wedding. All tattoos must cosmetically covered and all body piercing must be removed for each live broadcast on KGPE Television. All wedding and rehearsal dinner entertainment, program agendas and sequence of events must be approved by KGPE television two weeks prior to wedding day on May 18th, 2012. Only one (1) entry per couple. Only one (1) prize per household for the Contest/Contest. Only one (1) prize per household from any of the Company's stations within any thirty (30) day period. Employees of the Company, the Contest' participating sponsors, and their advertising agencies, employees of other radio or television stations, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

The Company disclaims all liability for any delays, miss delivery, loss, or failure in the delivery of any item sent by mail, courier, express, electronic transmission, or other delivery method. The Company is not responsible for mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, including: failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet or at any website or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online entrant's ability to participate in the Contest, and any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in the Contest. Entry forms in a register-to-win Contest must be handwritten. No photocopies or mechanical reproductions of entry forms is permitted.
